


Procedure: Setting up Hotbox Studios Email on a BlackBerry

Updated: 12/11/2013

This document explains how to setup your Hotbox Studios email account on a BlackBerry using the BlackBerry Internet Service (BIS) technology. BIS comes standard on every BlackBerry and is provided free of charge by your service provider.

NB: The setup process may vary depending on your wireless provider. You may need to consult the help documentation provided by your service provider.

1. On your PC or Mac open a browser and navigate to your service provider's BlackBerry Internet Service website. If you do not know your service provider's BlackBerry Internet Service website please contact your service provider.
2. Sign in with your Hotbox Studios email address and password and select **Next**.

3. When you sign-in, your account will then begin the verification process.

NB: some service provides may ask you to provide additional settings, if so please see below:

- User Name - enter your entire email address e.g. myname@mydomain.com
 - Password - enter the password for the account you're setting up
 - Email server - enter the following: **secure.emailsrvr.com**
4. After your account has been confirmed, you should receive the *Email Account Successfully Added* notification. Logout and your email should start populating after a few minutes.
